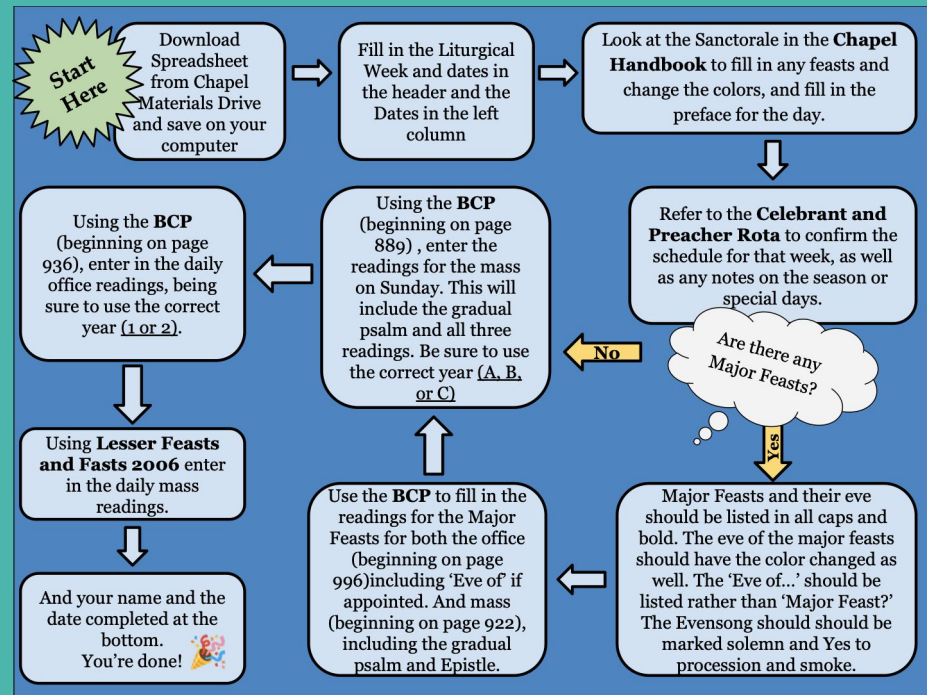

Major Feasts and their eve should be listed in all caps and bold. The eve of the major feasts should have the color changed as well. The 'Eve of...' should be listed rather than 'Major Feast?' The Evensong should be marked solemn and Yes to procession and smoke.
